

How to draw A PIPISTRELLE BAT

with Rusland Horizons and Eleanor Chaney

YOU WILL NEED:

- A sheet of paper
- A pencil
- A rubber
- A ruler
- A pen (fineliners with waterproof ink are useful but a biro will do!)
- Watercolour paints or colouring pencils if you would like to add colour



Step 1: In pencil sketch a small circle for the head.



Step 2: Add a larger pointed oval beneath for the body.



Step 3: Add small circle to the head to make the nose and mouth.



Step 4: Draw a diagonal line from the shoulder. Add a circle for the joint and draw another.



Step 5: And another two line to form the top of the wing.



Step 6: Sketch in another of these from the joint.



Step 7: Add one more to form the wing skeleton, and a triangle for the tail.



Step 8: Join these together to make the wing shape.



Step 9: Draw another line from the opposite shoulder.



Step 10: Add a triangle to this to form the second wing.



Step 11: Go over your drawing with pencil to add extra curves and shape.



Step 12: Add the details like the mouth, nose, ears and feet.



Step 13: You can now draw over your lines with pen, and rub out the pencil.



Step 14: Using small lines (hatching) and dots (stippling) will add detail.



Step 15: Your drawing is complete! You can now add colour with watercolour or pencil.
